Aloha Hawaiian Air Cargo Customer:

With respect to the February 1, 2009 AOSSP Change 5 mandating a 50 percent screening level for cargo transported on wide body passenger aircraft originating from the United States and territories, Hawaiian Air Cargo will restructure our cargo fees and acceptance standards.

CCSP (Certified Cargo Screening Program) and CCFS (Certified Cargo Screening Facilities) participants:

- No change in current drop time at CCSP approved airport
- Exempt from Security Charge for wide-body aircraft
- Exempt from Security Charge for narrow-body aircraft, provided shipment screened at 100%*

Non-CCSP/CCSF participants:

- Minimum four hour drop time for unscreened cargo tendered for Transpacific and International destinations
- We will continue to accept unscreened, customer built containers and skids for wide-body flights; however, customers must individually label interior pieces and provide piece counts documented on each air waybill.

The following chart outlines the fees that will be assessed **effective February 15, 2009**:
